- **Virtual Reality: This is how WE teach World War II history**

We know that students learn best through video and visualization. “Stand” on Omaha Beach or visit Pearl Harbor while hearing from the veterans who were there. “Wade” in the water. “Touch” the bunkers or sand. “Walk” onto the USS Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor or “into” the American Cemetery in Normandy, or the Punchbowl Cemetery on the island of Oahu. Find your way through the forests outside Bastogne, Belgium. You can find all VR films on YouTubeVR or on Oculus Quest TV.



- **Smartphone Global App: The WWII Streaming Channel**

From personal profiles and eyewitness storytelling, to modern-day archaeology and discoveries, the WWII Streaming Channel is the home of the best WWII documentaries covering all aspects of the War. All films are free to watch.

- **Social Media – Meeting People Where They Are**

By delivering history in small, digestible bits of information, The World War II Foundation effectively engages a diverse audience across all age groups. - **The International Museum of World War II: A Journey through History**

The International Museum of World War II invites school groups, educators, researchers, and the public from around the United States to share an overview of the personal stories of the WWII generation. Check out all our World War II Virtual Reality Films in the VR section of the Museum's theater. The Museum is interactive and focused on preserving these stories. It contains over 5000 WWII artifacts, more than 600 books which chronicle the stories of that generation, and a small theater, seating 35 people, which is a central part of the Museum's visual learning component. Named by National Geographic as one of the top ten World War II Museums in the world people should visit.



- **International Documentary Film, Photography and History Program**

The World War II Foundation, in collaboration with prestigious universities, engages students in immersive documentary filmmaking focused on World War II, blending education with hands-on experience in international settings. Starting in 2022, the program expanded to include multiple institutions, allowing students to create documentaries in countries like Italy, France, Austria, Germany and Switzerland. The program offers students valuable field experience in documentary production while deeply connecting them with historical events. This initiative not only enhances their academic and professional skills but also provides profound personal growth.

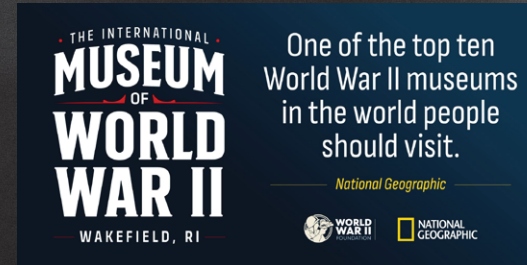


- **Sen. Bob Dole WWII Leadership Award**

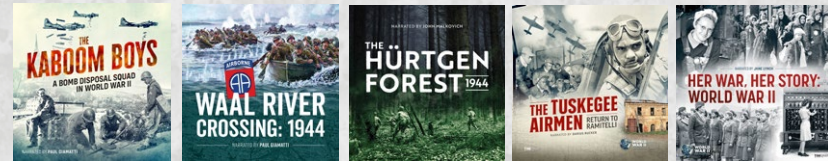
